Occupational Therapy

Occupational Therapists enable people of all ages to participate in the activities of everyday life. Occupational therapists achieve this outcome by working with people and communities to enhance their ability to engage in the occupations they want to, need to, or are expected to do, or by modifying the occupation or the environment to better support their occupational engagement.

They work with many different adults and children who have difficulty engaging in normal activities to achieve their daily living requirements.

- Assessment and training of personal and domestic activities of daily living (eg. self-care, domestic and community living skills)
- Home assessment and recommendations for home modifications
- Upper limb and hand therapy including fabrication and prescription of splints
- Scar and oedema management
- Prescription of assistive devices and equipment
- Cognitive assessment and therapy
- Perceptual assessment and therapy
- Education in areas such as relaxation, energy conservation, stress management, work simplification, fatigue management and leisure
- Childhood development (handwriting, perceptual, hand-eye coordination, jumping, walking, cutting, reading, writing)
- Behavioural support and understanding
- Sensory support and understanding
- Developmental difficulties i.e. perceptual/ language/ social development
- School difficulties
- Behavioural problems
- Learning/physical disabilities
- Neurological impairments/degenerative conditions
